OUR CAUSE

MENTAL HEALTH IN GREATER MANCHESTER

Throughout the Covid-19 pandemic, tens of thousands of Greater Manchester residents have faced extreme hardship and disadvantage, which has negatively impacted their mental wellbeing.

Such increases in mental health inequalities have led to increased pressure on Mental Health Services, meaning more people are waiting longer to receive support than they should be. Examples of the negative impact the pandemic has had on Mental Health are as follows;

50% **TWO YEARS**

25% of individuals referred into specialist mental health services wait more than three months to access specialist mental health services, with 15% of individuals waiting more than six months to access specialist support services. Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder sufferers have been known to wait more than two years for support.

3981 people in Greater Manchester per 100,000 are in contact with Mental Health Services, which is nearly 50% higher than the national average.

ANXIETY

The most common mental health conditions within the 16-30 age group are; Anxiety, ADHD, Depression/Mood Disorder and Schizophrenia.

18-29 year old's in Greater Manchester represent the largest cohort of individuals living with mental health conditions.



HOW CAN WE WORK TOGETHER TO IMPROVE THE MENTAL HEALTH OF THOSE IN GREATER MANCHESTER?

Working with qualified counsellors, Foundation 92 would like to create a brand new, supplementary free to access counselling service.

This service will provide individuals living with mental health conditions the opportunity to work exclusively with qualified counsellors, providing each individual with 30 hours counselling.

Specialist hubs will be created throughout Greater Manchester, in particular focusing on the following geographical areas;

**SALFORD.
TRAFFORD.
HULME.
EAST MANCHESTER.
TAMESIDE.**

Together we will help provide a total of 3000 hours of free counselling to 100 of Greater Manchester's most vulnerable individuals.

Working collectively we can help buck the above trend, helping more Greater Manchester residents improve their mental wellbeing, through the creation of a brand new, community outreach and counselling service.
